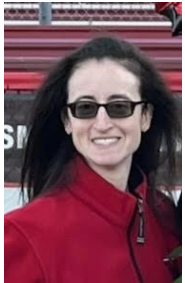


## Will Herlihy

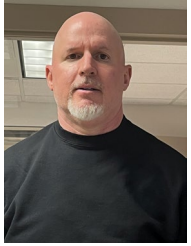
