- 300 million French-speakers in the world
- official language in 29 countries
- spoken on every continent



Spanish

- 500 million Spanish-speakers in the world as a 1st or 2nd language
- official language in 22 countries

Unified Arts

- **Art**

- Multi-medium hands-on instruction that exposes students to many types of artists

- **Music**

- Hands-on instruction in keyboards, guitars, etc. Students will learn how to read and write music

- **Technology Literacy**

- Students will learn the Office/Google Suite of programs, website evaluation, and basic coding

- **Science and Engineering**

- Hands-on curriculum exposing students to the Engineering standards from State Frameworks

Health & Physical Education

Alternate each of the 4 quarters - 7th grade will begin with Health

Health Units Include: Self-Care/Stress Management, Nutrition, Mental Health, Human Growth, etc - All based upon State/National Standards and Curriculum

PE Units Include: Team sports, Fitness, Teambuilding, First Aid, CPR, etc.

Advisory-Just Read- Performing Arts classes

Four Options for Two Elective Periods:

- Unified Arts** - Art, Music, Tech Ed, Engineering - one per quarter
- World Language** - French or Spanish
- Curriculum Support** - Special education class - Team decision
- Academic Support** - General education class - Family decision

Support Classes

Academic Support

- General education class
- Membership is determined by a family
- Typically coupled with UA not a WL
- In a small group setting, provides organizational support, study skills, etc.

Curriculum Support

Membership is determined by an IEP team decision

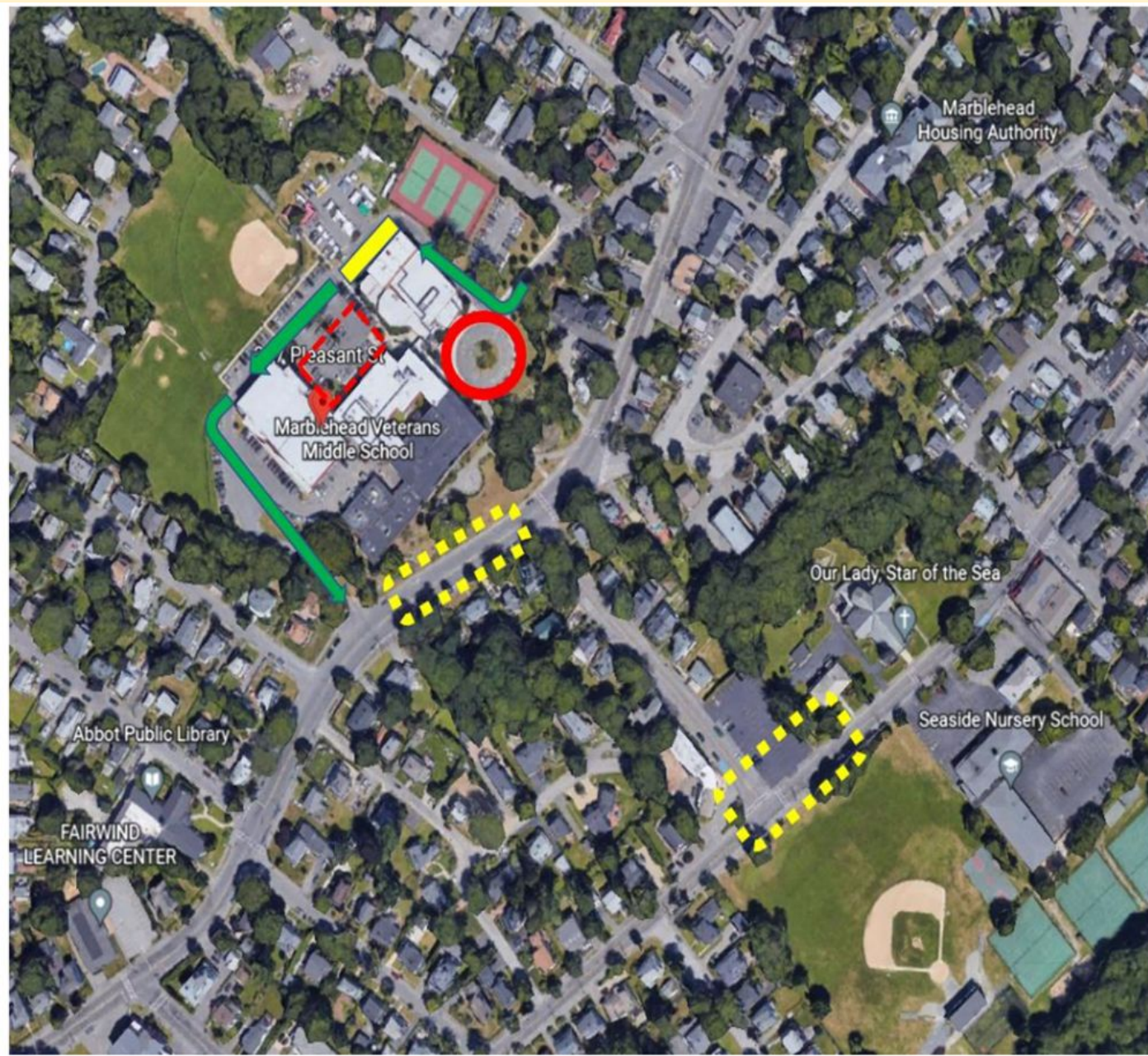

Green Arrows

One way path through our campus
