Unified Arts

Art

-Multi-medium hands-on instruction that exposes students to many types of artists

Music

-Hands-on instruction in keyboards, guitars, etc. Students will learn how to read and write music

Technology Literacy

-Students will learn the Office/Google Suite of programs, website evaluation, and basic coding

Science and Engineering

-Hands-on curriculum exposing students to the Engineering standards from State Frameworks

Health & Physical Education

Alternate each of the 4 quarters - 7th grade will begin with Health

- -<u>Academic Support</u> General education class Family decision


Support Classes

Academic Support

- -General education class
- -Membership is determined by a family
- -Typically coupled with UA not a WL
- -In a small group setting, provides organizational support, study skills, etc.

Curriculum Support

Membership is determined by an IEP team decision
