The Essex Agricultural Society DBA Topsfield Fair offers scholarships annually to *well-rounded students*. The Essex Agricultural Society has awarded over \$65,000.00 in scholarship aid to qualified students throughout the county. This year, EAS will again distribute scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 paid directly to your school, at the second semester of your freshman year and within 12 months of when the recipient was awarded. The Society also administers scholarships for the Essex County Farm Bureau and the Essex County Fruit Growers Association.

A copy of your high school transcript is required, although we look at all the activities and volunteer performances of the individual in order to base the decision of award.



This is a Non-Academic Award.

A 250- word essay will be required, answering the question of the year. The question for 2025 is:

From your agricultural work, FFA or 4H participation during your high school career, what are the two most important sustainable practices you will take with you and use for the rest of your life, and why?
