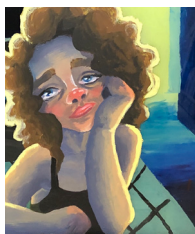

Computer Aided Drawing

Students will learn how to create technical drawings, learn the most widely used software package in the world, AutoCAD, and how to use the laser cutter and 3D Printer.

Graphic Design

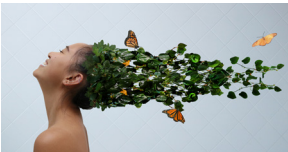
Students will develop overall computer illustrating skills, layout designs including but not limited to poster designs, logos, advertising, magazine layouts, and practice their typographic skills.

Photography

Students will learn to use 35mm film cameras and digital cameras. Picture-taking assignments will enable students to explore their creativity and develop their technical skills both in the camera and through editing software. Students also will study different photographers as well as photo genres.

AP Art History

This course will delve deeply into the role of art in shaping our global humanity. Students will explore the creative imagination and universal connections between distant cultures and time periods while developing research-based skills through intensive visual, contextual, and comparative analysis.

Woodworking

Students will be introduced to the use of woodworking tools and the pleasure of making something with their own hands. Students will learn the techniques needed to build basic to advanced projects using tools such as the table saw, miter saw, band saw, scroll saw, jointer, thickness planer and lathe.

Students will experience all phases of video production both in our digital television studio and out in the field. Live studio-based productions, field productions, editing, scripting, and special effects are all emphasized through the hands-on production of student video projects.

Are you interested in music, but haven't explored it before in-depth? These courses are for you! These single semester elective offerings explore different areas of music.

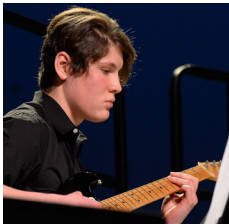
