DISPL	AY OF	FLAGS.	BANNERS.	AND	SYMBOL	IC DISPL	AYS

The Marblehead School Committee, as the governing and policy-making body of the Marblehead Public Schools, has the sole authority to determine that flags, banners, and similar symbolic displays on school district property reflect the mission, vision, and values if the school district and constitute the school district's government speech. The School Committee has therefore developed this Policy which his subject to the following rules:

1. Flags that have official legal status- The United States flag, the Massachusetts State flag, the POW/MIA flag, and the town of Marblehead flag- shall be displaced on school property. The school district shall also comply with the relevant provisions of G.L. c. 264, §8.
