RE: Submission of Statement of Interest to MSBA – School Roofs

At the current time we are planning to submit a Statement of Interest (SOI) to the Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA) for the replacement of the roof on the Marblehead High School and a portion of the roof at the Veteran's Middle School. The current estimates for the roofing projects are \$3.9 million for the High School roof and \$170,000 for the Veteran's Middle School roof. This Statement of Interest submission would be under the Accelerated Repair program offered by the MSBA. The due date for the statement of interest is Friday, March 25, 2022.

The submission of a statement of interest is to show the MSBA that we are in need of a building repair and that we hope to partner with them. This submission in no way guarantees us any funding, but this is just the first step in attempting to secure some funding for such a project. The timing and portion of funding is not known at this point in the process, but I can confidently state that this is not a particularly speedy process. If we are selected to move forward, our best guess is that the process to secure approval could take anywhere from 12 to 24 months or possibly longer. In speaking with the Project Manager from Leftfield who handled the Brown School Building project, a good estimate for percentage funding of the project is 36% for planning purposes.

Given the fact that we are in need of roof replacements and the deadline for the Statement of Interest is pending, we respectfully request your approval to submit the Statement of Interest for both the Marblehead High School and the Veteran's Middle School. The required motion of both the Board of Selectmen and the School Committee is listed below. A copy of the certified motion and vote will need to be filed with the statements.

Motion: To authorize the Superintendent to submit to the Massachusetts School Building Authority the Statement of Interest Form dated March 16, 2022 for the Marblehead High School and Veteran's Middle School located at 2 Humphrey Street, Marblehead, MA and 217 Pleasant Street, Marblehead, MA

respectively which describes and explains the following deficiencies and the priority category for which an application may be submitted to the Massachusetts School Building Authority in the future.

Description of priority: Priority category # 5 - Replacement, renovation or modernization of school facility systems, such as roofs, windows, boilers, heating and ventilation systems, to increase energy conservation and decrease energy related costs in a school facility.

Description of deficiency: The High School roof dates back to the initial construction which occurred in 2001. The entire roof has multiple leaks which have penetrated the building. The district has continually patched this roof to extend its useful life. It is a common occurrence for water to drip in through the ceiling during heavy rain storms. The Veteran's Middle School was most recently renovated in 2004 and previous to that in 1986. During the 2004 renovation all portions of the roof were replaced with the exception of the D Wing area and the Auditorium area. These two areas are now failing and are in dire need of replacement;

and hereby further specifically acknowledges that by submitting this Statement of Interest Form, the Massachusetts School Building Authority in no way guarantees the acceptance or the approval of an application, the awarding of a grant or any other funding commitment from the Massachusetts School Building Authority, or commits the Town to filing an application for funding with the Massachusetts School Building Authority.

Why Change the Schedule?

Time on Learning Requirement - DESE

- Directed study requires students to be engaged in activities directly related to their program of studies, and a teacher must be available to assist students.
- Traditional (non-directed) study halls are not considered "directed study."

I am pleased to announce that **Hope Doran** has accepted the position of Principal for the Glover Elementary School. Hope is currently the Assistant Principal of Penn Brook Elementary School in Georgetown, MA where she has served since 2014. Prior to that, Hope was the Interim Principal of North Intermediate School with the Wilmington Public Schools. While in Wilmington, Hope served as an Assistant Principal of Wilmington Middle School for three years and a sixth grade science teacher for eight years.

Hope earned her Bachelor of Education degree at Framingham State in Elementary Education, a Master of Education degree also from Framingham State University in Special Education and a Certificate of Advanced Graduate Studies in school administration from American International College.

One of Hope's references said "her greatest strength is caring about students." This was clear throughout the interview and forum processes. Her ability to be collaborative and inclusive with staff and families was evident in her responses and the printed materials she shared.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") entered into this _____ day of _____, 2022 by and between the Town of Marblehead ("Town") and the Marblehead School Department, by and through the School Committee ("Schools").

WHEREAS, in an effort to save the Town and the Schools money and provide more efficient and effective services and in an attempt to eliminate the duplication of services the parties are entering this MOU; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance thereof the Town and the Schools have determined that the Town may use the Eveleth School on a temporary basis to house the Abbot Public Library; and

WHEREAS, the parties understand that the MOU may be amended from time to time in order to fully realize the benefit of this arrangement and assure that the costs are properly accounted for against the responsible parties' budgets.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged and for the mutual promises set forth herein, the parties agree as follows:

Use of Facilities.

The Parties agree that the Town may use the Eveleth School located at 3 Brook Road, Marblehead, at no cost to the Town to house the Abbot Public Library on a temporary basis while the Town renovates the current Abbot Public Library Building.

Any permanent structural improvement or modification to the Eveleth School or its grounds by the Town must have prior approval of the Schools.

Services Performed.

The parties hereto agree that the Town shall be responsible for the following:

- Maintain appropriate and comprehensive building and liability insurance coverage for the Eveleth School location while the Town is using the location for the Abbot Library. The Town will provide the Schools with proof of insurance prior to taking occupancy.
- Cover all maintenance, general repairs, and building system repairs of the Eveleth School while the Town is using the location for the Abbot Library.
- Cover any and all costs associated with any modifications or improvements of the Eveleth School that is necessary for the Town to use the location for the Abbot Library.
- Obtain any building permits that are necessary for any repairs, modifications, improvements, and or upgrades to the Eveleth School during the term of the Agreement. Pay for the costs of all building utilities/services for the duration of the Agreement.

- Provide all regular upkeep of the Eveleth School , including, but not limited to the following:
 - Maintaining the grass and the field
 - Snow Removal from parking lots and walkways
 - Trash removal

Term and Termination.

Each party agrees that this MOU shall be effective from the date of execution through the remainder of FY23. In the event the parties desire to renew this agreement, they may do so with a mutually signed written agreement. No party may terminate this MOU without first providing the other with 90 clays written notice of termination. Upon said notice, at the end of the 90 period, this agreement shall be terminated and both parties shall be responsible for any costs incurred until the elate of termination.

Authority.

The persons signing this agreement represent that they have received the appropriate vote from the School Committee and the Town to enter into this MOU and said votes are attached hereto.

WITNESS on the date hereinabove, the duly authorized signatures of the Town and the Schools on two (2) counterparts of this MOU, each of which shall be considered to be an original, for all intents and purposes. This MOU shall be considered a valid and binding agreement between the parties.
